

Creation in Verse

Have you heard of the diamante poem? This is a poem written in the shape of a diamond, where the opening and closing of the poem are orthogonal to each other. They can be opposites (black/white or fire/ice) or complementary (seed/tree or lion/lamb) to each other. The poem follows a structure as described below.

Write your poem.

Line 1: Your beginning topic
Snow White

Line 2: Two adjectives about Snow White
